#### INTRO TO BROADCAST

#### Mission

Step into the world of live television with an exciting hands-on experience at TC Media Studio! Students will learn the fundamentals of live TV broadcasting, from planning and executing shows to delivering news like real anchors, weather reporters, or sports commentators. They'll also get a chance to operate a teleprompter or practice reading from one, gaining valuable insight into the fast-paced world of media production.

- Touring a professional TV studio and control room
- Participating in a mock live broadcast
- Practicing as a news anchor, weather reporter, or sports commentator
- Learning how to read from a teleprompter
- Operating basic studio equipment like cameras and microphones
- Discovering the roles of producers, directors, and technical crew in live TV





## BEHIND THE SCENES: PRODUCTION CREW ROLES

#### Mission

Discover what it takes to bring a live TV broadcast to life in this immersive, behind-the-scenes experience at TC Media Studio! Students will step into the shoes of a production crew, learning about key roles such as camera operator, floor director, sound engineer, and lighting technician. By working together to create a mock production, they'll gain hands-on experience in the teamwork and technical skills required for a successful broadcast.

- Rotating through various production crew roles
- Operating professional studio cameras and equipment
- Managing audio levels and sound quality as a sound engineer
- Controlling stage lighting for a live production
- Directing and cueing talent as a floor director
- Collaborating as a team to produce a mock TV segment





#### Lights, Camera, Action: Mini Movie Creation

#### Mission

Bring your creativity to life in this exciting 2–3 day after-school program at TC Media Studio! Students will learn the fundamentals of storytelling and filmmaking while working together to produce their own short film. From brainstorming and scripting to filming and editing, they'll experience every step of the production process using professional equipment. At the end of the program, they'll showcase their masterpiece in a special screening.

- Developing a storyline and writing a script
- Assigning roles such as director, actor, cinematographer, and editor
- Filming scenes using professional cameras and lighting equipment
- Learning basic editing techniques to piece the film together
- Screening the final production for the group





#### The Art of Storytelling: Creating a TV Segment

#### Mission

The students can unleash their creativity and communication skills in this engaging 2–3 day after-school program at TC Media Studio! Students will work together to develop and produce their own TV segment, whether it's a talk show, game show, or news feature. From brainstorming ideas to planning, rehearsing, and recording, they'll gain hands-on experience in bringing a TV concept to life. The program wraps up with a group screening to review their final production.

- Brainstorming and developing a unique TV segment idea
- Assigning roles such as host, guest, producer, and camera operator
- Planning and rehearsing dialogue, interviews, or show elements
- Recording the segment using professional studio equipment
- Watching and reviewing the final product as a group
